

MARBLE PAINTING



GETS GOOD RESULTS AND GREAT FOR CHILDREN (AND ADULTS) THAT DON'T LIKE LOTS OF MESS OR TOUCHING PAINT AND THE MARBLES MAKE A GOOD SOUND ROLLING ABOUT.

WHAT YOU NEED:

AN OLD SHOE BOX (YOU WON'T NEED THE LID)

PAPER

PAINT

PLASTIC CUPS OR CONTAINERS

SPOONS

MARBLES

Cut some paper to fit inside the shoe box, can be any shape, (square, circle, butterfly, car, dinosaur etc...)

Put some paint in to the cups and add a different marble in to each pot, you can use as many or as few colours as you want.

Use a spoon to take out a marble and drop it in to the box.

Hold the box and tilt it in lots of different directions so that the paint covered marble rolls around the inside of the box and over the paper.

WHEN YOU WANT TO USE A DIFFERENT COLOUR, TAKE THE MARBLE OUT AND DROP IN A DIFFERENT PAINT COVERED MARBLE AND REPEAT THE ROLLING UNTIL YOU HAVE A FABULOUS COLOURFUL PICTURE!
