


STRING PICTURES



CAN GET QUITE MESSY BUT GREAT FUN AND GOOD FOR CHILDREN THAT LIKE TO FEEL DIFFERENT TEXTURES.

WHAT YOU NEED:

LARGE PIECE OF PAPER -FOLDED IN HALF

PAINTS

PAPER/PLASTIC CUPS OR PLATES

STRING OR WOOL CUT IN TO LENGTHS

Put some different colour paints in to cups or on to a plate. Open out the folded paper.

Put a piece of string or wool in to each different colour paint (this is where it gets messy!) making sure they are well covered.

Lay each different coloured piece of string or wool on to one side of the paper and make sure that one end of the string/wool is slightly over the edge of the paper.

Close the paper over the string and press down. One at a time, gently pull each piece of the string out from between the sheets of paper.

Open up the paper and see the lovely patterns you have made!

IF YOU HAVE A CHILD THAT DOESN'T LIKE MESS, TRY GIVING THEM A PAIR OF TWEEZERS SO THAT THEY CAN USE THOSE TO PULL THE STRING OUT.
